Incorporated in 1954 our mission is to promote an enriching environment where rugby can be played and the culture enjoyed by all ages and backgrounds regardless of gender or ability, through active volunteerism & membership.

Our Women's Division competed in the Niagara Rugby Union's development division in 2007, which they won and gained promotion to the NRU A Division in 2008. From 2012-2015 the team was in the NRU B Division and in 2016 won promotion to A.

Internal coach education and development is high on our list of priorities and we now seek an ambitious individual who shares our goals to take the lead Coaching role of our Women's Rugby programme commencing pre-season 2018.

The ideal candidate will have experience as a Head Coach or Assistant Coach at the senior club, post-secondary, or provincial level of play.

Qualifications and Skills:

The Head Coach shall prepare, plan, organize and supervise all coaching as required for the entire 2018 Season.

- The coach should possess a minimum of Level 1 coaching certification in Rugby with the goal of progressing to Level 2 and 3.
- The coach shall set the standard with regards to behaviour during practices and games, respect of officials and opposing teams, and expectations of all players in all divisions.
- The coach shall delegate where required and be able to work well as a team with respect to other coaches, and ensure that all divisions are playing the same rugby structure.
- The coach shall be responsible for challenging all players and maximizing their development while ensuring that the team comes first, and that playing rugby provides enjoyment, fun, and safety.
- The coach shall ensure that fair play and pride in the Hamilton Hornet's RFC is paramount at all times.
- The coach must be able to communicate with the Board, coaching staff, players, volunteers, alumni, and all other Rugby Club members as well as be a leader in promoting the Hamilton Hornet's RFC brand in the community.
